| Course Title: | 2 Day Locator Awareness Course |
| Course Identifier: | RIICCM202E – Identify, Locate and Protect Underground Services |
| Intended Audience: | This course is ideal for workers at all levels of the civil construction industry, general trades and safety professionals looking to gain a greater understanding of the impact of underground services on design and construction works. Service locators will benefit greatly from a strong practical focus on the use of electromagnetic (EM) locating devices. |
| Course Objective: | Raising the awareness of the presence of underground services and enabling the participant to assess their own and/or other staff and contractor's competency. The course focuses on the DBYD process, safe excavation and EM locating of services with a specific emphasis on increasing locating accuracy. |
| Course Description: | This course is delivered face to face over two consecutive 8-hour days. A variety of strategies are employed to ensure maximum benefit to the adult learner is achieved. The course will involve lectures, demonstrations, practical work scenarios and open discussions. Participants are assessed on both theory and practical elements. A Statement of Attainment is issued upon successful completion of the course. Locating equipment is supplied however students are invited to bring their own locating devices. |
